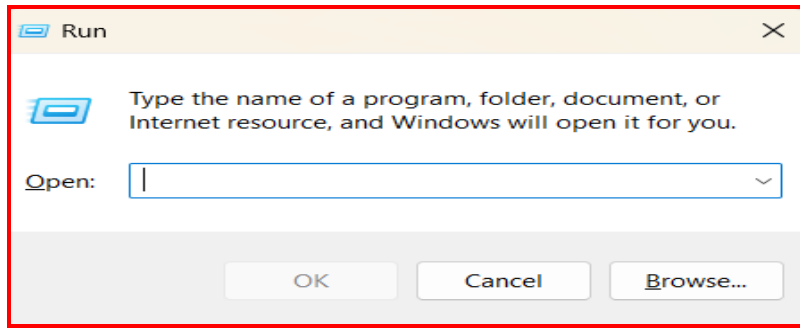

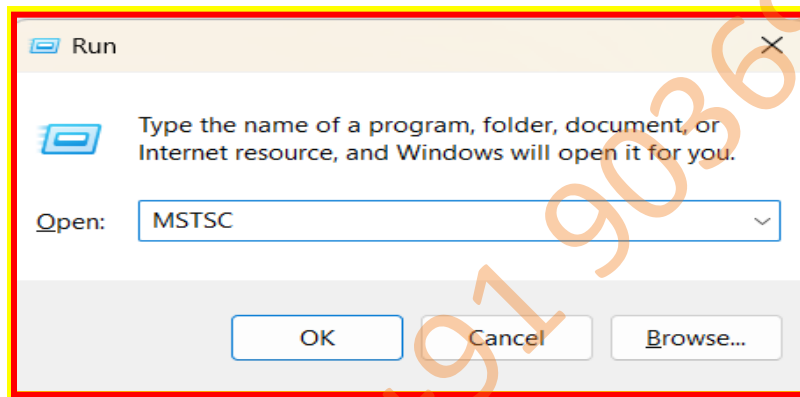


### SAP Remote Desktop Connection (RDP) from a Windows system
